Fact Sheet: State Disability Insurance Online



Use <u>State Disability Insurance (SDI) Online</u> (edd.ca.gov/SDI_Online) to file Disability Insurance (DI) and Paid Family Leave (PFL) claims and forms. With SDI Online, you can also:

- Access DI claim status and payment history.
- Receive immediate confirmation of claims filed and DI forms submitted.
- Access forms in English and Spanish.

Who Can Use SDI Online?

Individuals filing DI or PFL claims, employers, licensed health professionals, and voluntary plan (VP) administrators can use SDI Online to submit claims and additional documents.

Voluntary Plan

VP employers and third-party administrators may register for an account by contacting a VP representative at 1-916-653-6839 or via email at VPProgram@edd.ca.gov.

How Can I Sign Up?

Visit <u>SDI Online</u> (edd.ca.gov/SDI_Online) to create an account. Individuals will need:

- Legal name.
- Valid email address.
- Date of birth.
- Social Security number.
- California Driver License or Identification Card number.
- · Physical address.
- Mailing address (if different from physical address).
- Valid phone number.

- Employer account number.
- Zip code used when business first registered with the EDD.
- Total subject wages from the *Quarterly Contribution Return and Report of Wages* (DE 9C).

Employers must be registered with the EDD in the state of California.

More information licensed health professionals will need:

- Medical license type.
- Medical license number.
- Treatment address.

Medical representatives can register for SDI Online once added as an authorized representative.
